

Introduction

The DRYVIEW Laser Imager is a continuous-tone laser imager with an internal photothermographic film processor. Heat, rather than photo chemicals, is used to develop the film. This easy-to-use and reliable imager provides high-quality prints.

The system receives and prints from qualified image sources such as medical equipment (modalities) and workstations over the network. You can send print jobs simultaneously from multiple image sources. The open design lets you connect to modalities of all types and vendors.

Purpose:

Use this checklist to ensure that all guidelines and site specifications for installation of your DRYVIEW Laser Imager have been fulfilled. Preparation for installation is your responsibility; however, Carestream has resources available to help you if needed. Review the requirements contained in this document and, if you have questions, please contact your Authorized Carestream Service Provider.

Installation Tools

A new feature for LINUX OS systems is the ability to use various web browsers including

CHROME, FIREFOX, or INTERNET EXPLORER to access DRYVIEW Laser Imager WebLink pages. The following versions are tested as compatible to access WebLink pages, although other browsers may also work:

- MICROSOFT EDGE
- GOOGLE CHROME, 76.0.3809.100 (or higher)
- MOZILLA FIREFOX, 64.0.2 (or higher)

For the "basic install" the latest Secure Link and WebLink versions are not required, however for advanced troubleshooting/set up it is required to install on your service laptop Secure Link Client version 3.2.4.02 or higher. Please refer to Carestream Service Assets web page for further information.

The following tools are required to complete installation of the DRYVIEW Laser Imagers:

- WINDOWS 10 Laptop
- PHILLIPS Screwdriver for unpacking
- Side-Cutting Pliers for unpacking
- Voltmeter for checking source AC power
- Latest Secure Link and WebLink versions


Prior to installation, you must order and have available the appropriate film. The DRYVIEW Laser Imager may support the following film sizes (support can vary by location and imager configuration):

- 20 x 25 cm (8 x 10 in.)
- 25 x 30 cm (10 x 12 in.)
- 28 x 35 cm (11 x 14 in.)
- 35 x 43 cm (14 x 17 in.)
- General radiography and mammography film types are available. Contact your Carestream Authorzed Distributor or Dealer to order DRYVIEW Laser Imaging Film.



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
DRYVIEW 6950 Laser Imager <u>with</u> sorter









Location Requirements

(X) Important:

Place the DRYVIEW Laser Imager in an area with good ventilation. **A small, confined room is not recommended**.

Avoid placing the DRYVIEW Laser Imager in **direct or excessive sunlight** (for example, near a large window), or in an environment with dust, dirt, or airborne chemicals.

Temperature

Recommended temperature: mid-range within the operating environment: 15–33 $^{\circ}$ C (59–91 $^{\circ}$ F).

Relative Humidity

Recommended relative humidity: mid-range within the operating environment: 20–80 % RH, non-condensing.

Operating Space Requirements

- The DRYVIEW 6950 Laser Imager requires a flat, level floor space and at least 61 cm (24 in.) around the top, sides, and back.
- The DRYVIEW 5950 Laser Imager and DRYVIEW 5700 Laser Imager require a flat, stable surface (stand or table) that supports the dimensions and weight of the imager. The surface must extend beyond the imager dimensions by at least 31 cm (12 in.). In addition, there must be space in front of the imager to allow access in the event of a service call.
- Recommended surface height for the DRYVIEW 5950 Laser Imager and DRYVIEW 5700 Laser Imager is 71–76 cm (28–30 in.).

Note:

An optional stand is available for the DRYVIEW 5950 Laser Imager and DRYVIEW 5700 Laser Imager. Designed at the optimal height and size, the stand provides the proper clearance to move the imager in the event of a service call. The stand is an orderable accessory.

Power Requirements

- A power cord is provided with this equipment. All countries must use an agencyapproved power cord with a plug type suitable for the country of use. Connect the equipment to a power source that is suitable for the voltage and current ratings at your site.
- For regions where equipment power is unstable, The use of a Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) 1.5 KVA is highly recommended to ensure the correct current supply.
- The single-phase power source, with grounding, must be provided within 2.5 m (8.0 ft) of the DRYVIEW Laser Imager.
- The wire must be insulation-rated for input voltage = 600 V (ac). A dedicated line is recommended.

Network Requirements

- The imager receives digital images from medical imaging devices (modalities) over a 10/100/1000 Base-T Ethernet network. During the installation, Carestream personnel or Biomedical Engineers (in countries where applicable), will enter the network information for the DRYVIEW Laser Imager to let it communicate across the network.
- An RJ-45 network plug is required for connecting to the 10/100/1000 Base-T Ethernet network.

Smart Link and Remote Management Services (RMS)

Background

Carestream Health has adopted IDM (Intelligent Device Management) innovative technology to provide the most effective remote service offering in the industry. The solution designed by Carestream is named **Smart Link Remote Management Services (RMS)** and it is based on PTC Internet of Thing (IoT) technology which allows Carestream to deploy remote services securely over the Internet to equipment installed behind customer firewalls. Customer does not have to modify any of their network security policies. The solution is designed for high performance and security at every level of its architecture. Refer to Smart Link White Paper, 8J4352 available on Carestream Service Assets web page.

The remote connection is established by the RMS Smart Link agent embedded into the software of Carestream equipment. The minimum requirement is to allow the Carestream equipment local IP address to establish secure outbound communication over the Internet through the port 443 (https) and allow the agent to contact a DNS server (public or private) to resolve host names of the targeted Smart Link servers of the PTC IoT Cloud. There is no need for any special network connections or special changes to customer Proxy Server if presents.

When the connection is established your Carestream equipment can provide performance data, alerts, and alarms to our support team, resulting in proactive, rapid service and support with advanced remote troubleshooting capabilities.

Customer Site Firewall Configuration to Allow Carestream Device to Connect to RMS Smart Link Server

To guarantee a successful RMS Smart Link connectivity, provide the following to the customer's IT department Some adjustments may be necessary by the customer IT.

The site IT manager must configure the firewall to let the Carestream device to communicate with the Carestream secure Smart Link servers (PTC IoT cloud). To facilitate the configuration, please provide the following information to the IT manager:

- TCP/IP port 53 is used to sync data between the DNS servers, while UDP port 53 is used by the Carestream device (DNS client) to resolve the URL (e.g., Production Enterprise server, see above table) via the DNS server. The DNS server on site will still need to sync data with DNS servers outside.
- Host/IP pairs above may be changed unpredictably by PTC for security reasons, so it is recommended to always use a DNS to resolve the latest updated host's IP pairs.
- Depending on the customer site's security policy, the site IT manager could configure the firewall in 3 different ways:
 - (Recommended) Allow the Carestream device to reach the "*.axeda.com", "*.thingworx.com" and "*.cn-ptc.cn" in the domain restriction rule.
 - The "axeda.com", "thingworx.com" and "cn-ptc.cn" are IoT domains of Carestream Secure Smart Link servers (PTC IoT cloud) reserved by PTC (see Host column of above table).
 - **(Alternative 1)** Allow the Carestream device to reach all Carestream secure Smart Link servers (PTC IoT cloud) listed above, in the selected sites restriction rule. Customer needs to update the list accordingly to Carestream.
 - (Alternative 2) Allow the Carestream device to reach all internet sites, no restriction rule. By the way the Carestream device will always communicate only with cloud's servers which belong to **axeda.com**, **thingworx.com** and **cn-ptc.cn** domains.

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
